TESTING: As a matter of policy every orphan kitten we get in gets tested for FeLV and FIV. In a litter of kittens with no mother, we test one kitten randomly. In a litter of kittens with the mother cat coming in we test the mother cat. We can at any stage retest any cat if our vets advise us to due to chronic illness. Only cats testing negative for these two viruses are available for adoption.

PLEASE NOTE: It is in the best interest of the kitten and adopter to RETEST your kitten at 6 months old for FeLV and FIV. The testing of young kittens is always risky due to their age because the FeLV virus can be in incubation for up to 90 days
